Tultion Policies

- Tuition is charged in 11 equal payments August -June regardless of the number of classes in the
 month. Whether we have a short month (2 weeks) or long month (5 weeks), tuition amount
 remains the same. Payments do not vary due to holidays or the number of weeks in a
 month. Tuition and fees are non-refundable and there are no refunds. You may pay in advance for
 tuition or fees.
- Tuition is due on the 1st of every month and must be paid to participate in dance class.
- **Tuition will not be prorated** due to Late Month Registration, Holidays, Vacations, Absences, Studio Closures and/or Holidays, Vacations, Absences, Studio Closures and/or Illness.
- Accepted Payment Methods: Visa, Mastercard, cash and personal check made payable to Daliana Dance (be sure to include child's name on check). Credit Card Payments may be made via your Portal.
- \$25.00 fee on all returned checks
- You must provide credit card information to be registered.
- Tuition is late if paid after the 10th of the month. Tuition received on the 11th or later will incur a **\$15.00 late fee.**
- Outstanding Balances: Students whose account balances are delinquent 30 days past due will
 not be able to attend dance classes, or participate in special events such as parades or
 showcase.
- Illness. **Tuition is charged regardless of the number of classes missed**. Make up classes are available for ages 5 and up.
- **You may not "skip" a month** or late fees will be incurred Enrollment is understood to be for the 11 month dance season, August 2019- June 2020. Students on competition team will have a varied ending based on National Competition.
- Tuition is non-refundable and not transferable.
- Make-up classes are available if dancer is ill, injured or if there's a family emergency.
- If you choose to withdrawal from the studio a 30 day written notice must be received otherwise, you are responsible for said tuition. No refunds.
- There is a \$5.00 charge for changes made to enrolled classes after statements have been sent.

Studio Policies 2019-2020

Dance class is education and fun, however, an important part of class work is developing an attitude of discipline and respect for teachers and fellow students. We trust that following our classroom etiquette will provide an environment whereby classes at Daliana Dance will be a pleasure for all concerned.

Please note the following guidelines regarding all classes:

- 1. We request that students carefully observe our dress code outlined in this booklet. Specifically NO STREET SHOES IN STUDIO, dance shoes only!! Sneakers used for hip hop should not be worn outside.
- 2. No cell phones are allowed in the dance studio classroom. Exception: Adult student with an "on-call" work position. (must be on vibrate).
- 3. Dance students only in classrooms, no spectators, and no children are allowed in adult classes. (Parents are allowed to observe in 3-5 year old classes). Out of town guests may request to visit at any time throughout the year. No one else is allowed to sit and watch during regular class time without prior permission from Daliana.
- 4. Water Only allowed in classroom (NO SPORTS DRINKS OR FOOD in classroom EVER)
- 5. Do your very best at arriving for classes on time to receive full benefit from your class time and not to be disruptive to class already in session.
- 6. All students are encouraged not to leave the room once class has begun. Please allow for appropriate restroom use prior to class. Very young children will be treated as the need arises. Preschool children may need a parent's attention from time to time for various reasons such as bathroom assistance. Please do not leave the waiting room when very young children (Ages 2-4) are in class without having another parent or adult responsible during your absence. We make every effort to have all children feel safe and cared for in a loving and inspiring learning environment.
- 7. School age children, teens and adults: please practice respect. While we want you to have fun, please refrain from socializing in the classroom as it is disruptive to both the instructors and other students. Please come early or stay late to enjoy friends in the waiting area. Please honor your teacher and fellow students by giving full attention and cooperation. You will be advised if we feel any student is not well adjusted to the classroom environment for any reason over time.
- 8. During class if a student complains of being ill or sustains an injury and cannot participate the instructor will send them to the front desk where the parents will be notified if not on the premises.

Dress Code

Failure to attend class in proper attire can result in, but not limited to NO PARTICIPATION of class for that day, conditioning such as planking or crunches. Please be sure your child has the required tools for class. Mom please do not come to the instructor with why they are not prepared seeking special exception.

- Sports Bras in Age Specific Colors are available for purchase and may be worn by ages 13 and UP. Younger girls attending belly dance may wear sports bra to that class.
- A neat and tidy appearance sets an attitude of attentiveness and respect for students, teachers, and the art of dance.
- Teachers must be able to see the dancer's body outline clearly in order to make proper corrections on posture, alignment, etc.
- Hair must be properly secured and tied up off of the face and neck for all classes except hip hop. For safety, if you have hair beads, you must wrap hair when dancing.
- NO Jewelry.
- NO Gum.
- NO street shoes, NO blue jeans, NO sloppy or oversized t-shirts or sweatshirts as they
 are not dance attire.
