Registration & Tuition Cost Information

Registration Begins July 15, 2020

New Student Registration Fee \$35.00 (non-refundable, existing students no fee)

Tuition is calculated by an hourly rate system which provides a discount when you register for more than one weekly class. Here are our competitive hourly rates. Discounts are especially deep when registering for Unlimited classes as well as for families with multiple children.

Tuition Policies

- Tuition is charged in 11 equal payments August -June regardless of the number of classes in the month. Whether we have a short month (2 weeks) or long month (5 weeks), tuition amount remains the same. ***Payments do not vary due to holidays or the number of weeks in a month.*** Tuition and fees are non-refundable and there are no refunds. You may pay in advance for tuition or fees.
- Tuition is due on the 1st of every month and must be paid to participate in dance class.
- Tuition will not be prorated due to Late Month Registration, Holidays, Vacations, Absences, Studio Closures and/or Holidays, Vacations, Absences, Studio Closures and/or Illness.
- Accepted Payment Methods: Visa, Mastercard, cash and personal check made payable to Daliana Dance (be sure to include child's name on check). Credit Card Payments may be made via your Portal.
- \$25.00 fee on all returned checks
- You must provide credit card information to be registered.
- Tuition is late if paid after the 6th of the month. Tuition received on the 6th or later will incur a ***\$15.00 late fee.***
- Outstanding Balances: Students whose account balances are delinquent 30 days past due will not be able to attend dance classes, or participate in special events such as parades or showcase.
- Illness. **Tuition is charged regardless of the number of classes missed.** Make up classes are available for ages 5 and up.
- **You may not "skip" a month** or late fees will be incurred Enrollment is understood to be for the 11 month dance season, August 2020- June 2021. Students on competition team will have a varied ending based on National Competition.
- Tuition is non-refundable and not transferable.
- Make-up classes are available if dancer is ill, injured or if there's a family emergency.
- **If you choose to withdraw from the studio a 30 day written notice must be received otherwise, you are responsible for said tuition. No refunds.**
- **There is a \$5.00 charge per class for changes made to enrolled classes after statements have been sent.**

Purchase from Carolina Dancewear:

Each shoe brand and style fit very different from your street shoes. They have a list of required footwear for Daliana Dance. It is best to purchase from them and "Support Local Business"

Outdoor Classes: It is OK to NOT wear tights, however for ballet a black skirt may be added or a skirt that matches your leotard color may be worn, NO SHORTS for Ballet!!!! Please see ballet skirt purchase options above.

It is required that students to abide by our dress code policy

Specific leotard color and shoe info are based on age division.

Failure to attend class in proper attire can result in, but not limited to NO PARTICIPATION of class for that day, conditioning such as planking or crunches. Please be sure your child has the required tools for class. Mom please do not come to the instructor with why they are not prepared seeking a special exception.

Class Policy:

- Class size is limited to 10, in some instances 12 will be allowed. Wait list will be available for closed classes
- Social distance of 6ft is marked in all classrooms

Absenteeism:

- No REFUNDS for missing class or dropping a class mid month
- Make up classes are available for most, but not guaranteed
- If 3 or more acro classes are missed, your child will be removed
- Please communicate when dropping a class

Drop Off-Pick Up

- Student should wait in car until given thumbs up by instructor
- Parents of dancers age 3-6 are asked to remain nearby in vehicle for just in case assistance is needed
- Temperatures will be taken
- Be prompt with pick up as students are not allowed to loiter

Lobby:

- Lobby is currently CLOSED
- Only dancers may enter to use restroom with mask on

Daliana Dance Definition of Classes

New Normal:

Be flexible and adaptable as safety during pandemic will dictate much of what, when, where and how we do things!

Hybrid Classes Explained

Outdoor Hybrid (OH): Classes are held on location at Daliana Dance Outside with instructor present. Class will also be Live Streamed via Zoom. There is however NO interaction between Zoom attendees and Instructor due to visibility and sound challenges.

Indoor Hybrid (IH): Classes are held on location at Daliana Dance indoors with instructors present. Classes will also be Live streamed via Zoom with full interaction between instructor and at home participants.

Virtual (V): Online Only

In Person (IP): Regular in person classes no virtual access

Outdoor Hybrid Inclement Weather Advance Notice: Instructors will Zoom from Studio with Full interaction of Zoom Attendees

Outdoor Hybrid Inclement Weather "Unexpected" and class is already in session: Class will resume indoors with doors open.

Masks: if you choose to wear a mask, it needs to be light and breathable. (Bloch makes them and my experience has been great.)

Clear face shields: I highly recommend these to be worn both indoor and outdoor for all genres EXCEPT for acro.

Your respect for the safety guidelines and transparency we have established are appreciated. Please remind your child we are being safe so that we can continue to bring them together for what they love to do!

What to bring to Outdoor Classes: ***All items should be small/travel size and fit into one bag that dancer will carry from class area to class area*

***All items must be properly labeled as there is no lost and found, any/all items left behind will be thrown away.*

- Sunblock
- Larger than normal Water Bottle
- Bug Spray
- Personal Spray Fan
- Personal Clip On fan for Ballet Barre (keep cool and shoo mosquitos)
- Hand Sanitizer
- Personal sanitizer wipes
- Tissues
- Small Towel
- Ziplock Baggie for personal trash
- Dance Booties (this will make going to the bathroom and transitioning from Class to class much easier. (Shop Carolina Dancewear)
- Clear Poncho for unexpected drizzle
- Lightweight Black Leggings
- Lightweight Breathable Long sleeve tee shirt

Virtual Class Assistance Page:

Proper dance attire is still expected with virtual teaching!

We are so happy to see smiling faces online!! This is a growth process and will do all we can to ensure that these dancers maintain and gain skills!!

- Test your link as soon as you receive it, it's best to figure out the kinks before class starts!
- Test out your wifi connection in your planned working space so that you don't drop from the connection.
- Please don't have your lighting "behind" you, we are still making individual corrections to "privatized class attendees," so we want to see you as clearly as possible
- Have your planned space ready, take a few minutes to do a safety check to make sure cords, rugs, tables, lamps, etc. are away from your dance space.
- Join class early so we can make the most of our time together. Each class will have a few minutes of saying hello in beginning and end.
- If you do not receive an invitation for a class you or your child attends, after I have communicated that invite was sent, please let me know!
