A dancer's class placement can change based on progress and growth or lack thereof, availability, or any other issue deemed appropriate to consider.

Class Expectations

TARDINESS

Arriving to practice more than 15 minutes late is considered tardy.

If your dancer is tardy (15 minutes late or more) then she/he has missed the warm up and will need to do so independently before joining in with the class. In some cases they may have to sit out depending on the lesson. If, in the opinion of the instructor, your tardiness is excessive and hampering progress of the individual or the class as a unit, the dancer can be dismissed from said class without a refund.



ABSENCES

Always inform your instructor via BAND if your dancer will not attend class. If, in the opinion of the instructor, your absences are excessive and hampering progress of the individual or the class as a unit, the dancer can be dismissed from said class without a refund.



INCLEMENT WEATHER

Safety is always the first priority. In the event of predicted or actual inclement weather before and or during classes, the Studio Owner will post class status on BAND.

Tuition is charged in 12 equal payments August -July regardless of the number of classes in the month. Whether we have a short month (2 weeks) or long month (5 weeks), tuition amount remains the same. Payments do not vary due to holidays or the number of weeks in a month. Tuition and fees are non-refundable and there are no refunds. You may pay in advance for tuition or fees.

Tuition is due on the 1st of every month and must be paid to participate in dance class.

Tuition will not be prorated due to Late Month Registration, Holidays, Vacations, Absences, Studio Closures and/or Holidays, Vacations, Absences, Studio Closures and/or Illness.

If you choose to withdraw from the studio a 30 day written notice must be received otherwise, you are responsible for said tuition. No refunds.

You may not "skip" a month or late fees will be incurred Enrollment is understood to be for the 12 month dance season, August 2022- July 2023.
